1. Instructor Coach (multiple positions)

- July – August.
- Time commitment is flexible with minimum of 2 weeks.
- US Sailing Instructor Certification preferred. Sailing experience must. Experience with Optimist, Club 420, Interlakes or Flying Scots is preferred.

2. Race Coach (multiple positions)

- July – August.
- Time commitment is flexible with minimum of 2 weeks.
- US Sailing Instructor Certification and racing experience.
- Coach 420 and Opti teams.

3. Power/Safety Boat Operator/Instructor

- July – August.
- Instruct how to safely operate a powerboat.
- Time commitment is flexible with minimum of 2 weeks.
- Provide boat towing, on water rescue support.
- Emergence coordinator.
- Experience operating a powerboat in close quarters.
- MI DNR Boating Certification required.

4. Launch & Haul-out Team Member (multiple positions)

- An unlimited number of positions are available.
- Set up boats, equipment and classroom for the classes. Reverse setup after classes are done.
- Timing - Launch Tuesdays and Thursdays 10AM to Noon May through June. Haul-out Tuesdays and Thursdays 10AM to Noon until done.
- Time commitment - Works as much or little as you like. Just show up.
- No skill or experience required. This is a great opportunity to work around the water, learn about boating and make new friends.

5. Maintenance Team Member (multiple positions)

- An unlimited number of positions are available.
- Prepare and repair boats and equipment.
- Timing - Launch Tuesdays and Thursdays 10AM to Noon May through June. Haul-out Tuesdays and Thursdays 10AM to Noon until done.
- Time commitment - Works as much or little as you like. Just show up.
- Mechanical, electrical, woodworking or general boat repair experience.

6. Online Fund Raising Managers

- Position functions include setting up and managing online fund raising i.e., Go Fund Me, Amazon Smile, etc. Managing communications with individual donors, sponsors and potential sponsors.
- Functions will be distributed between volunteers based on skill and interest.
- Time commitment is flexible.
- Work from home.

7. Social Media Web Manager

- Help manage website.
- Coordinate promoting awareness of the program on social media.
- Time commitment – very flexible.
- Work from home.

8. Participant Recruiting and Registration Managers

- Distribute online recruiting and other program announcements to organizations, schools and individuals.
- Some hardcopy mail solicitations primarily to schools and churches.
- Confirm registration and payments from participants.
- Maintain participant data list.
- Time commitment is flexible.
- Work from home.

9. Finance/Accounting Manager

- Work with DCSC Treasure to track and document income and expenses.
- Donation acknowledgements.
- Time commitment is flexible.
- Work from home.

10. Activity Coordinator (multiple positions)

- July – August.
- Assist instructors in supervising participants during off water periods.
- Assist in maintaining participant safety.
- Manage communications with parents during the program.
- Help organize activities i.e., lunch parties, orientation, graduation picnics, etc.
- Manage parent visits during classes.
- Time commitment is flexible.

11. Online Boat and Equipment Sales Manager

- Manage sales of excess equipment and boats.
- List online (Facebook Market Place, Craigs List, etc.), take calls, answer emails and schedule viewings.
- Position only involves interacting over the phone or online with prospective buyers. Viewing the boats, agreeing on a final price and transferring ownership will be handled by others.
